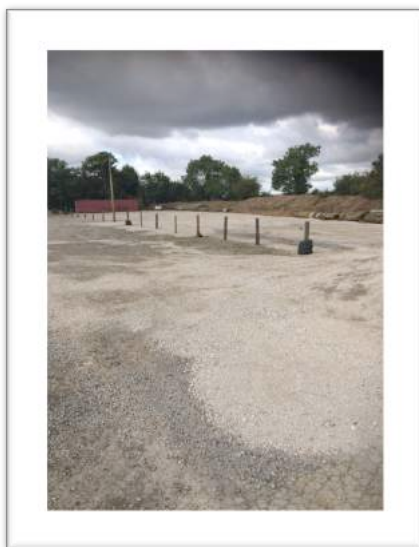

Car Parking at Collinstown

The facilities team led by Martin Quilty have undertaken and completed the extension to the car park at Collinstown this week. Many tasks have been undertaken by contractors and club members last week including the skimming of topsoil and moving soil to build up a secure bank at the roadside hedge, moving and banking of bark mulch, grading of soil to get it as level as possible, moving of all weather strips etc . Parking continues facing the new pitch and now it is also possible to park facing the hedge where the bark mulch formerly was. The team have put up poles down the middle to let people know to park facing them from both sides. Please get familiar with this new area, how to manoeuvre around it and the additional parking opportunities it presents. Please do not block access areas. This extension should help to solve a lot of challenges we face there to facilitate all the cars for matches, blitzes, training etc. We need your continued support to park properly and follow instructions of mentors appointed by teams/groups to park safely. This has been one of many projects completed this year with respect to improvements to playing areas and access in addition to improving Club facilities in general. The facilities team aim with the support of the Executive and other committees to push ahead and try to make our Club the very best that it can be.
