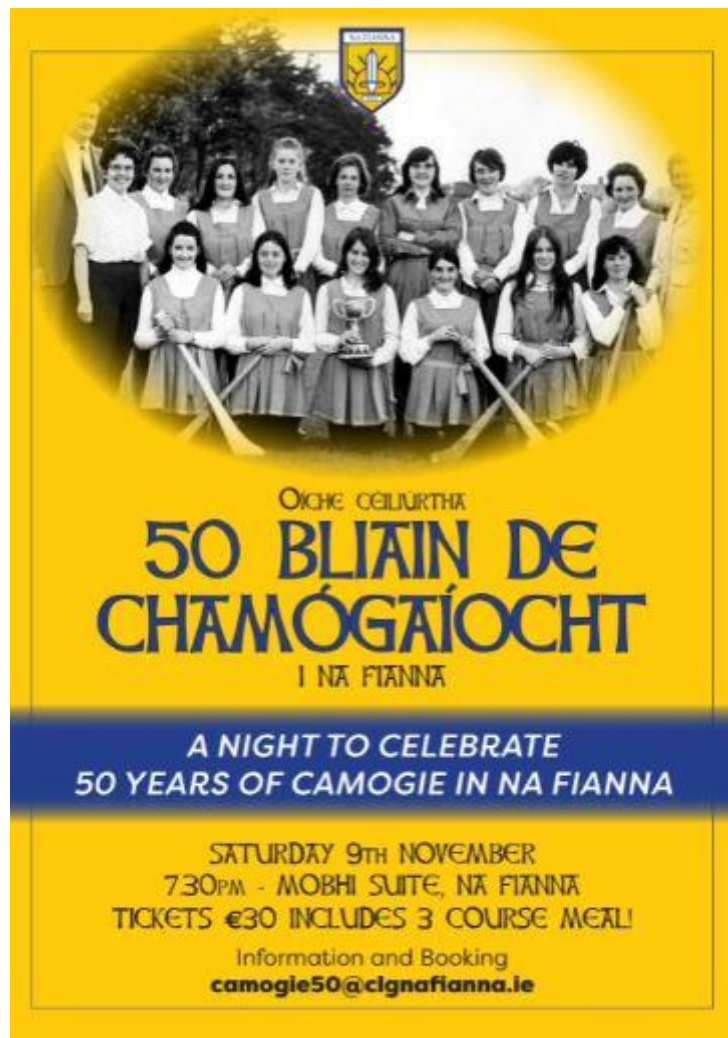

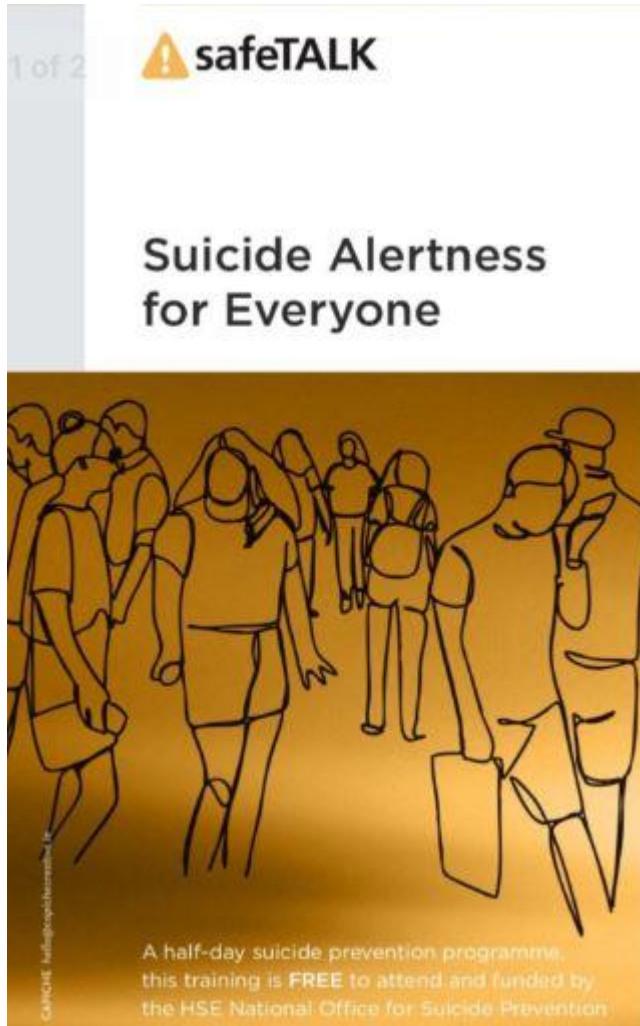
Drumcondra Library
